The evening also hosted the Tyler Mason Memorial for the IMCA Modified division.

Tim O'Brien moved under Scott Webb for position number two while Vic Coffey moved around Ryan Phelps for position. In the DIRTcar Street Stock position, Jerrod Radley and Todd Raabe led the field to green with Jerrod Radley jumping out to the lead.
